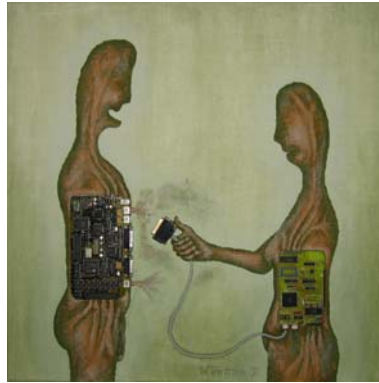

Exhibition 2008

The exhibition on **Art & Science** will be based on the **works of 3 artists**, which have in common a **background in the field of the natural sciences**, and with their artistic work being clearly influenced by their scientific education and activity in research and/or teaching. Despite of these common features, their artistic positions and approaches are rather different:

- **Wolfgang Trettnak (Austria; www.trettnak.com)**
- **Kurt Zapfel (Austria; www.zapfel.com)**

The planned exhibition will comprise **approximately 10 works of each artist**, which will be provided with **supplementary plates** containing additional information on the scientific background, process of work, and the ideas and philosophies behind. This will emphasize also a **didactic aspect of the exhibition** and will facilitate understanding the art work and the creative process involved.

At the moment, the following **exhibition sites** are envisaged for **2008**:

- **Graz (Styria, Austria) - Bildungszentrum Raiffeisenhof**, education centre for adult people
- **Leoben (Styria, Austria) - The University of Leoben, Department of Automation**
- **Budweis/Ceské Budejovice (Bohemia, Czechia) - The golden house of European culture**

Additional places for the exhibition are in discussion.

For the **inauguration** of the exhibition it is planned to make a **short presentation** on the relevance of the topic **Art & Science** and on the interactions of these fields, which seem to be so contradictory.

In Austria Dr. Michal Giboda will be invited for this purpose. He is chairing the organization **“Dialogue between Science and Art” (www.sciart-cz.eu)** in Czechia, which is organizing exhibitions, workshops and publications on this subject.
